



## 2009 Cruise Event Info

**Hello and thank you for your participation in the 2009 Hot Pedro Nites Classic Car Cruise, benefiting Clean San Pedro! Below you will find important information about the event:**

**Date:** Saturday, August 22, 2009

**Time:** 6:00pm to 9:00pm

**Cruise Route:** Between 6<sup>th</sup> St. and 16<sup>th</sup> St. on Pacific Ave. EastBound on 7<sup>th</sup> St. between Pacific Ave. and Centre St. NorthBound Centre St. between 6<sup>th</sup> St. and 7<sup>th</sup> St. WestBound on 6<sup>th</sup> St. between Centre St. and Pacific Ave. ([See Map Here](#)).

**Cruise Entrance and Exits:** Registered Vehicles can enter the cruise at **5<sup>th</sup> and Pacific ONLY**. There will be no other entry areas along the cruise. Cars can exit the Cruise at **16<sup>th</sup> and Pacific and 6<sup>th</sup> and Pacific**.

**Turn a round:** There will be a turn around at 16<sup>th</sup> St. and Pacific Ave. The route will become one lane between 15<sup>th</sup> St. and 16<sup>th</sup> St. for the turnaround. Please be prepared to merge.

**Car Check In:** **ALL cars MUST Check In before entering the cruise.** Check In will be from 3:00 pm to 6:30 pm. on Saturday. It will be in front of The Auto Palace on 5<sup>th</sup> St., just East of Pacific Ave. Cars that have not pre-registered may register and pay to participate in the cruise at Check In the day of the cruise.

**Window identification plaques** will be given at Registration and must be displayed on your front windshield on the **passenger side**. L.A.P.D. Motor officers will be checking for proper identifications on windshields. A vehicle without the proper identification will be pulled over and is subject to a violation.

**Traffic Rules:** All traffic rules should be observed including stopping for red lights and stop signs. This allows for pedestrian crossing of Pacific Avenue. Parking along cruise route is reserved only for registered vehicles of the cruise.

**Reservation:** Hot Pedro Nites reserves the right to restrict participants to acceptable behavior during any and all activities. If any reason participant or his vehicle, their appearance or conduct is deemed objectionable, the participant will be subject to removal. Hopping, burnouts or any other activity deemed unsafe is not permitted. **NO ALCHOL is allowed along the cruise route – in cars or on the street. The route will be monitored by L.A.P.D and they will enforce all traffic laws and event rules and give citations where necessary.**
